Lighthouse Emergency Services (Lighthouse) is continuing its existing energy assistance program that is designed to identify the immediate crisis of potential disconnection, followed by an in-depth interview session to identify the source of the crisis, and develop a plan to prevent the crisis from reoccurring and assist the client to move toward self-sufficiency.

Program Details

- Intake process is approximately 75 minutes; basic information obtained and eligibility verified
- In-depth assessment of personal and financial situation; financial education
- Client is asked to commit a portion of their own funds toward resolving the crisis, if possible
- Average \$498 available per household
- Clients can receive assistance for each type of utility only once during the 12 month grant term
