

New, unusual courses offered at Community Center

Formal in-person registration for Farmington Community Center's winter session will be from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., January 3 and 4, at the Center.

A long list of classes and workshops are being offered to all family members. An unusual workshop dealing with the Korean-finger calculation method called Chisanhop will be taught by Chris Klein, an educator with the Troy school system. The method is reported to make math more understandable.

Taxpayers may meet the April 15 deadline with more ease after learning Income Tax Preparation with instructor Anne Struble.

Investing in Antiques returns with J. Jordan Humberstone at the helm. He is on the acquisitions committee for the

Detroit Historical Museum. The course will cover American clocks, toys, Oriental rugs, quilts and coverlets, folk art, and early lighting devices.

The world of miniatures debuts this session with four classes. Bertha E. Eagan teaches Introduction to Miniatures and Miniature Christmas Trees. Stella Semczuk leads students in two classes: Miniature Accessories for Doll Houses and Miniature Flowers and Bread Dough Items. Both instructors are teachers at Greenfield Village and active in miniature shows throughout the area.

Cooking enthusiasts will have three new classes. Erwin Wagner leads a class called Creative Meatless Menus. Mr. Wagner has gained admirers around the Metro area with creative

approach to food preparation and combination.
