School Board Alters Policy

Two minor changes in graduation requirements have been approved by the Farmington Board of Education.

Another policy stated "14 credits shall be required in grades 10 through 12, nine of which must be earned in grades 10 and 11." This has been rephrased to read "14 credits shall be required in grades 10 through 12."
