Learn Advanced Guitar At Community Center

FARMINGTON Advanced guitar will be offered at the Farmington Community Center by Cathy Svoboda on Thursdays beginning Feb. 12.

Two after school classes will be scheduled for the younger set—one at 4 p.m. and one at 5 p.m. An evening class at 8 p.m. will provide instruction for other teens and working people.

The fee is \$21 for 12 sessions. Instruction will include orchestra, chords and single notes so that the student may play his own melodies. Music that appeals to the individual will be stressed. Classes will be limited to six.

Miss Svoboda has studied guitar professionally for five years. She participates in folk masses at St. Clare's Church and also makes appearances in coffee houses and in school programs in our area.

Mrs. Vicory has just moved to the Farmington area. She still handles the ballet classes for the Jackson Recreation Department's Fine Arts program. In this capacity she has done an outstanding job and received wide recognition.

Her background is very unusual. At the age of 14 she received a government scholarship to study ballet at the State Opera in Hamburg, Germany. Following years of training in ballet, toe and character, as well as dancing in ballets and operas, she graduated from the opera school with honors and started her career as a dancer and teacher.

SHE HAS STUDIED under choreographers such as the Russian Tarjiana Gensovsky and made many appearances on the stages of Europe.

Coming to America she took instruction in the Chetvetil method from such professionals as Smith, Jory, Brantiska (New York) and Madame Skeping (London).

While Mrs. Vicory is highly qualified to provide advanced students with excellent instruction, she is also interested in introducing adult and teen beginners to the fun and physical fitness to be achieved through dancing.
