

# Meadowbrook triumphs; Orchard 2nd

The Meadowbrook Country Club swim team ran up 1,143 points to win the Suburban Inter-Club Swim Association championship meet last Friday and Saturday.

Orchard Lake Country Club was second with 616. Bloomfield Open Hunt Club was fourth with 550. Pine Lake Country Club was fifth with 568 and Birmingham Country Club was sixth with 472.

Orchard Lake was helped through the efforts of six double winners. John Schwab won the 8-and-under boys' 25-meter backstroke (21.03) and 25-meter freestyle (17.57); Mark Shagena won the 11-12 boys' 50-meter breaststroke (39.26) and 50-meter butterfly (32.03); Renee Brenner won the 9-10 girls' 25-meter butterfly and 25-meter freestyle (14.49); Sarah Holsington won the 11-12 girls' 50-meter butterfly (34.23) and 50-meter freestyle (31.32); Kristyn Knauss won the 13-14 girls' 50-meter backstroke (34.26) and 50-meter freestyle (29.32); and Sue Green won the 13-14 girls' 50-meter breaststroke (38.29) and 13-14 100-meter individual medley (1:13.61).

OTHER LOCAL double winners were Steve Pancratz of Pine Lake Country Club in the 9-10 boys' 25-meter backstroke (17.71) and 25-meter freestyle (15.05); Gina Bratrude of Bloomfield Open Hunt in the 15-17 girls' 50-meter backstroke (33.27) and 50-meter butterfly (31.54); Mike Hanahan of Birmingham Country Club in the 15-17 boys' 50-meter butterfly (29.19) and 50-meter freestyle (25.93); and Bill Grady of Forest Lake in the 13-14 boys' 50-meter breaststroke (35.79) and 50-meter freestyle (27.06).

# Ho hum, Surf swimmers win

There were no surprises in Sunday's Northwest Suburban Swim League Championship Meet at Beech Woods swimming pool in Southfield.

The Bloomfield Surf Club did it again, winning the meet for the fourth consecutive year.

Surf piled up 802 points on its way to the victory. Woodside Athletic Club of Beverly Hills was second with 612 points and Heart of the Hills of Rochester was third with 535 points.

The Beach-Wood Recreation team of Troy finished first in B Division and eighth overall with 327 points. The Beach-Wood team moved into A Division with that point total, knocking the Cranbrook Swim Club of South-

field into B Division.

Cranbrook finished the meet in ninth place with 283 points. The first eight swim teams qualify for A Division competition next season.

THE LEAGUE MEET featured 13 individual championship records and one relay record.

Doug Cleland of Heart of the Hills and Guy Del Franco of Bloomfield Surf paced the boys by setting two records each. Cleland set marks in the 15- to 14-year-old boys' 50-meter backstroke (30.316) and 100-meter individual medley (1:05.177). Del Franco turned in record clockings of 28.944 in the 15-17 boys' 50-meter backstroke and 1:03.711 in the

100-meter individual medley.

Kara McGrath of Woodside paced the girls with records in the 15-17 girls' 50-meter butterfly (29.659) and 100-meter individual medley (1:08.153).

Other individual record setters were Rob Kramer of Forest Hills in the 13-14 boys' breaststroke (34.515); Jill Andries of Woodbrooke Hills in the 13-14 girls' 50-meter breaststroke (36.661); Ryan Ringold of Farmington Glen in the 7-8 boys' 25-meter (17.909); Bob Mackle of Bloomfield Surf in the 15-17 boys' 100-meter freestyle (54.806); Lisa Watkinson of Bloomfield Surf in the 11-12 girls' 50-meter butterfly, and Lori Elliott of Bloomfield Surf in the 13-14 girls' 50-meter backstroke (32.021).

Woodside's 64-year combined girls' 200-meter freestyle relay team set a record with a 1:54.168 clocking.
