Murder suspect to undergo preliminary exam

The preliminary examination of a Farmington Hills man facing two charges of murder in the stabbing death of a Livonia woman will continue April 7.

District Judge James Mies will hear legal arguments on five felony charges against Wade Gregg, 22, before deciding whether the suspect should be bound over for trial in Wayne County Circuit Court.

Gregg is being held without bond in Wayne County Jail, pending a temporary transfer to the state forensic center in Ypsilanti for psychiatric examination. The psychiatric test will determine if Gregg is competent to stand trial.

Gregg has been charged with first degree murder in the Feb. 8 slaying of Juanita Waluzak. He is also charged with murder in the commission of a felony, first degree criminal sexual con-

duct and two counts of assault with intent to commit murder.

The murder charges are different. Evidence of premeditation, or forethought must be proved to convict a defendant of first degree murder. To

convict a defendant of felony murder, the prosecution must only prove that a felony crime was being committed when the victim died.

Defense attorney David Lawson said he would not recall prosecution wit-

nesses who testified at a Feb. 24 preliminary exam.

Gregg also allegedly tried to rape one of Mrs. Waluzak's daughters and stabbed another daughter's boyfriend.
