

Cooking classes set to go

Three popular Farmington Community Center cooking classes are set to begin the week of April 5 with instruction in Chinese, economical gourmet and natural-foods cooking heading the list.

Tan Tchen, one of the area's most-respected authorities on authentic Chinese cuisine, will share new recipes perfected during her recent trip to China.

Cooking I is an introduction to "Chinese Cooking" and the professional techniques students are unable to learn from a cookbook. It will begin on Tuesday, April 7. Cooking II is a continuation but emphasizes more-elaborate recipes. In each class, students learn how to prepare an ideal menu for a complete meal and receive foolproof recipes.

Both classes will meet from 7:30-10 p.m. for three sessions. Fee is \$42 for each class. The advanced class will begin on May 12.

BARBARA DERMODY will continue her "Economic Gourmet" cooking class after a very successful winter

run. Soup-to-nuts demonstrations and sampling will inspire students to create new dishes for their families with economy in mind.

Mrs. Dermody has a wide experience in cooking and teaching. She shares her recipes from her many travels to Canada and Europe.

Her class will begin on April 7 and meet for four sessions from 9:30-11:30 a.m. The fee is \$25.

Bonnie Breidenbach presents her popular "Natural Foods" classes to students who are interested in preparing pure, natural foods for practical nutrition, beginning on Tuesday, April 7.

This eight-session class will focus on hearty soups, sugarless desserts and whole-grain breads. Fee is \$45. Class meets from 7:30-9:30 p.m.

Miss Breidenbach is a graduate of the East-West Foundation in Boston and has traveled extensively in western Europe studying natural foods. She has taught many classes and lectured on the subject in area schools.
