

Mabel Fake surprised on her 75th birthday

The monthly "Family Night" event in Trinity Episcopal Church was turned into a special event for Mabel Fake. During the evening, while Ms. Fake was speaking, numbers of friends, neighbors and family arrived for a surprise celebration of her 75th birthday.

She was born in Plymouth, attended what is now Eastern Michigan University and is a life-long resident of the area. Her interests include membership or affiliation with the Botanical Society, Nomads, Hikers Club, Cranbrook Institute of Science, League of Women Voters, Audubon Society and Trinity Church.

Members from each of these groups shared vignettes of her life during the birthday celebration.

This ranged from a trip she took in a wash tub on spring flood waters at age 6, through her sharing of botanical and bird knowledge with inner city and Trinity church school children, up to her work as a political rights champion.

Maria Runk, president of West Bloomfield-Farmington League of Women Voters, described her "as a nurturing, caring, accepting, understanding person with an absolute sense of priorities."

On Broadway, she has appeared in "Morningstar," "For Heaven's Sake"

and "How to Be a Jewish Mother."

In movies, she played Frank Sinatra's mother in "Come Blow Your Horn." On radio, she and her husband starred in "Mr. and Mrs." for more than 20 years.

Her autobiography, "Molly" was published in 1980.
