Belter furniture on display

The new exhibit in the Plymouth Historical Museum is of furniture made by John Belter (1804-1883), who came to the United States in the early 1840's, started making furniture a few years later and made furniture until his death.

His furniture features richly carved frameworks in rosewood and walnut with heavy rolled moldings and intricate fruit and floral decoration.

Belter's greatest achievement is generally considered to be his successful application of laminating. He used pressed work (plywood) with veneers over, steamed and shaped to a curvilinear form under pressure. The furniture was then pierced and carved to create the effect of openwork carving in a curved plane, an effect that would have been impossible to achieve with natural wood.

Joseph Meeks & Sons during the 1850s and 1860s produced substantial quantities of carved, laminated furniture in the rococo manner.

The Plymouth Historical Museum, located at 155 S. Main Street in Plymouth, is open Thursday, Saturday and Sunday from 1-4 p.m. Admission is \$1 for adults, 50 cents for youth 12-17, and 25 cents for children 5-11.
