

Fishing derby launches activities

A fishing derby Saturday on the campus of the Community College of Farmington will kick off Farmington Hills' summer recreation activities.

Boys and girls looking for a bite of fun should fish the watering hole behind OCC. Expect a pond stocked with fish just for this event.

Activities begin at 8 a.m. Prizes will be awarded at noon. There's a \$2.50 charge for each participant and pre-registration is required.

All residents of Farmington and Farmington Hills are eligible for any activity or class offered by the recreation department. Registration is accepted at the recreation office in City Hall, 11 1/2 and Orchard Lake.

Supervised activities including sports, dance and arts & crafts are planned when 10 Farmington-area playgrounds open on Monday, June 22. There will be a \$4 fee per participant, \$2 for two or more in one family. The fee is new this year to cover the cost of sports supplies and sports equipment.

Hours will be 9-11:30 a.m. and 12:30-3 p.m., Monday through Thursday through July 30.

Centers are Dunckel Middle School, Filander Forest, Hill, Larkshire, Longacre, Middlebelt Grace, Woodcreek and Woodchick elementary schools.

COM-ON-A-WONNA day camp is being offered in four sessions to children ages 6-8. Camp activities include

fishing, archery, hiking, campfire programs and a field trip.

The camp site is at OCC and transportation is the responsibility of the parent. Hours are 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. every weekday except Thursday — the evening reserved for a picnic and campfire.

Weeklong sessions begin June 29, July 13, July 27, and Aug. 10. The fee is \$25 the first week (which pre-empts Friday for the Fourth of July holiday) and \$28 for the other five day sessions.

In cooperation with the Michigan Recreation and Park Association, the Hills recreation department will be offering a variety of fun tickets at special savings.

Tickets will be on sale at the recreation department and city of Farmington's finance department.

Places include Bob-Lo, Cedar Point, the Detroit Zoo, Kings Island, Sea World and others. Savings on general admission tickets range from 50 cents to \$3.20.

Swimming instruction for beginner to advanced skill levels will be offered at Farmington and North Farmington high schools.

Pre-registration is necessary and will be handled on a first come, first serve basis.

Each two week instructional session consists of daily classes which meet Monday through Thursday. Fee is \$15.

SAFETY TOWN will be offered again this summer to teach tots road

safety.

Instruction includes pedestrian, motorist, bus, stranger, police, fire, railroad crossings, bicycle, drugs, general play and home safety.

Movies, bus songs, a bus trip to the Fire Department and practice training on a road course set up for Big Wheels is included.

The 20-hour course is designed for children entering kindergarten this fall; all other 4-, 5- and 6-year-olds will be accepted. The fee is \$22, which includes a T-shirt and certificate.

Sessions will be at the Shawwassee Recreation Center, on Shawwassee west of Middlebelt, between Nine Mile and Orchard Lake.

The first session begins June 22. There are eight sessions.

Farmington Hills along with Southfield and Oak Park are offering a day camp for mild to moderately handicapped youth.

Camp Rainbow is an eight week day camping experience featuring swimming, camp crafts, basic camping skills and field trips. There will also be an overnight camp offered three times during the summer.

Session I is July 6-10, Session II July 13-17, and Session III July 20-24, at Oakland Community College. Time is 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The fee is \$21 for non-campout sessions and \$23 for campout session.

BASIC SAILING is being offered this summer. The class will enable students

to gain basic sailing knowledge in the theoretical, practical and safety aspect of the sport.

Sixteen foot to 20-foot sailboats will be used for instruction. Upon successful completion of the course, students are issued a basic sailing certification by the American Red Cross.

Minimum age is 12 years. Students basic swimming skills may be tested.

The cost is \$65. The class will be at the Bloomfield Beach and Boat Facility, at 4300 Cass-Elizabeth Lake road in Waterford Township.

Wind surfing will also be offered again this summer. The excitement of hanging off a sail in high wind at speeds over 20 miles an hour is offered in this four hour course.

The course will teach basic wind surfing techniques. Lessons will be taught on dry land simulator and on the water with wind surfers.

The fee is \$32 and classes will be at the Bloomfield Beach and Boat Facility.

A new parent series is offered this summer. The seven-week Lamaze childbirth education class prepares expectant parents to participate fully in their birthing experience.

There will be two sessions. The first begins June 25, the second Aug. 20. The fee is \$35 per couple.
