

Lung disease vaccine tried

A new vaccine is on the way for the tongue-twisting lung disease — coccidioidomycosis, which often is shortened to cocci.

According to the American Lung Association of Southeastern Michigan (ALASEM), a permit to test the new vaccine has been granted by the Food and Drug Administration. Approximately 3,000 unpaid volunteers will be inoculated, and the test will take about three years. The disease is endemic to parts of California, Arizona, New Mexico and Texas.

Cocci is a fungus disease caused by a tiny form of plant life somewhat like yeast or mildew. The tiny spores, called spores, are found in dust and are inhaled into the lungs, and inflammation results. Little patches of pneumonia can develop around the spores. At such a stage, flu-like symptoms can develop. Cocci also can spread throughout the body, and death can result.

The vaccine's developer, Hillel Benjamin Levine, Ph.D., a research bacteriologist in the Naval Biosciences Laboratory at Oakland, Calif., said the vaccine is the first to have potential against a fungus affecting human beings.

Levine, with others, has been working on the vaccine for 25 years. He first tried it on mice and monkeys, then

himself, then other volunteers. Researchers predict that in three years science may have an answer to this dust-borne lung disease, a particular bane to tourists who become ill after a visit to the Southwest — and their doctors back home have no clue as to cause.
