PAUL C. MORTENSON

Mr. Mortenson, 63, of Farmington Hills is presumed dead aboard a

domed twin-engine aircraft off Alaska's southern coast Cape Yakataga on Sunday, Sept. 13.

Mr. Mortenson studied mechanical engineering and business administration at the universities of Wisconsin and Southern California.

He was retired director of engineering and business administration of Sundstrand Corp. in Ames, Iowa, and vice president of Sperry-Rand Vickers Division, Troy.

He had published many articles and received awards such as the Meritorious Achievement Award from the U.S. Department of Defense and the Distinguished Performance and Contribution Award from the Society of Automotive Engineers.

An SAE member for 28 years, he served on its board for four years. He also belonged to the National Fluid Power Association (20 years) and the American Management Association (18 years).

Mr. Mortenson had a strong commitment to leadership development in foreign missions. For more than 15 years, he has served Far Eastern Gospel Crusade in a variety of consultant roles. He chaired FEGC's finance committee, conducted management seminars and advised the mission in administration and finance. He formerly served on the U.S. board of FEGC.

Before his death, he made a large

contribution to help defray costs for leadership development in the mission. Mr. Mortenson is survived by his wife, Lillian; son, Ron Mortenson of Plymouth; daughter, Linda Ladd of North Carolina; four grandchildren and a sister, Jean Jensen of Racine, Wis.

A memorial service will be conducted Monday night at 7:30 p.m. at Highland Park Baptist Church, 28600 Lahser, in Southfield.

THE REV. PHILIP E. ARMSTRONG

Mr. Armstrong, 61, is presumed dead in an aircraft that crashed Sept. 13 off Alaska. Mr. Armstrong was former general director of Far Eastern Gospel Crusade for 31 years.

A Michigan native, Mr. Armstrong has lived in Birmingham and Farmington Hills since 1961. Son of a missionary to China, he graduated from St. Olaf College, Northfield, Minn., and Moody Bible Institute, Chicago, Ill.

He also studied at the universities of Michigan and Minnesota, as well as the

University of the Philippines. He was ordained by the First Baptist Church, Bronson, Mich., and served with the Rural Bible Mission.

Mr. Armstrong fought in the Pacific during World War II and helped establish the GI Gospel Hour in Manila. Out of these associations was formed the Far Eastern Gospel Crusade in 1948. From its beginning, Mr. Armstrong served as general director of the mission, now numbering 330 missionaries in Alaska, Japan, Taiwan, the Philippines and the Yukon. Since 1980, he has been minister of missions.

Mr. Armstrong served with numerous intermission groups. He has been the president of the Interdenominational Foreign Mission Association and currently was a member of the executive council. He was a recognized mission-

ary statesman, gifted speaker, minister of the Scriptures and teacher. He has been a visiting professor at numerous seminaries and Bible colleges, notably Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, Deerfield, Ill., and Columbia Bible College, Columbia, S.C.

Mr. Armstrong is survived by his wife, Bobbie; two daughters, Karon Burkland of Minnesota and Mary Kelly of Florida; two brothers, Dr. Theodore Armstrong of Washington and David Armstrong of Minnesota, and one granddaughter.

A memorial service will be conducted at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday night at Highland Park Baptist Church, 28600 Lahser, Southfield.
