

# Suit Against College Still Only Threat

As of Monday afternoon, Schoolcraft Community College Trustee James Boswell had yet to ask a court restraining order against the college board, which he said last week he was going to do.

At the regular board meeting Wednesday, Boswell, who is the elected representative of the Livonia School District, told fellow trustees that he believes the board is "illegal and unconstitutional."

He said this may make "me liable for illegal activity if I take part" and he stalked out when the meeting was less than five minutes old. He threatened to seek a court order to restrain the board from operating Monday afternoon the Wayne County Circuit Court records clerk said a petition for such an order had "not yet" been received.

Boswell, who has an unlisted telephone, was unavailable for comment.  
MRS. JANE MOCHLE, board chairman and the Plymouth School District representative, stated: "In view of the absence of any injunction, we will proceed with the meeting as a college board constituted by the Legislature."  
Boswell referred to a recent U.S. Supreme Court decision affecting a Kansas City, Missouri, community college and said it supports his long-held opinion that the Schoolcraft board is malapportioned.

He charged that "you have been aware of this for two to three years...aware of letters I have sent" to various government agencies.  
Mrs. Mochle, in particular, as president of the board, is "either negligent or incompetent in not bringing this issue to a head before this time," said Boswell.  
"I am going to seek a temporary restraining order," said Boswell, adding that he has already secured an attorney for the purpose.

BOSWELL'S FIGHTS with the board on this and other points have been many since he was elected five years ago. He has frequently remained away from the board table, at one point last fall missing three meetings in succession. The Supreme Court ruling to which he referred is currently being researched by the board's attorney, Edward Driscoll of Plymouth. His off-hand opinion has been that significant differences between the composition of the trustees of the Kansas City board and Schoolcraft's board indicate that it will not likely force reappointment.

## Petitions Available In C'ville

Nominating petitions are available in the Clarenceville Board of Education office for those interested in seeking terms on the board. The terms of board members Richard Wood and Robert M. Erickson will expire June 30.

Nominating petitions must contain not less than 20 nor more than 50 signatures of qualified registered school electors in the Clarenceville District. The new terms will be for four years each. Signed petitions must be returned to the board office no later than 4 p.m. May 9. Date of the school board election is June 8.


