**YOUTH INSTRUCTIONAL BOWLING** — In cooperation with Bel-Aire, Country and Nor-West Lanes, we will offer a comprehensive weekly program for 3rd, 4th and 5th graders which will teach individuals correct lane approach, ball delivery, timing, scoring. Classes begin the week of Feb. 21. The time will be 4:30 p.m. during the week and 9:30-11 a.m. at Nor-West Lanes Saturday only. The fee is \$12. Registration deadline is Feb. 18.

**AMATEUR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION WORKSHOP** — The Metro-Detroit Amateur Softball Association invites all adult softball team managers from the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation leagues to its third annual
