## EMU Plans Workshops

Two high school workshops in theater will be offered at Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, this summer by the speech and dramatic arts department.

The beginning workshop, scheduled for June 21 through July 4, will offer introduction to theatre, improvisation, rehearsal and performance, oral interpretation and play production.

The advanced workshop, scheduled for Aug. 2 through 15, will cover theatre aesthetics, directing, rehearsal and performance, technical theatre and scene study.

Young men and women, 16 through 18 years old, who have talent and an interest in the crafts of theater should enroll in the beginners' workshop. Other students in the same age group who have had extensive theater experience or who have participated in a summer program should enroll in the advanced workshop.

A graduate seminar for teachers and prospective teachers of dramatic arts in secondary schools will be offered in conjunction with each workshop. Two hours of graduate credit may be earned by enrolling in Speech and Dramatics 596, a seminar in directing high school drama or advanced high school drama.

Applications and information may be obtained by writing to Coordinator of University Conferences, Division of Field Services, Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, 48197. Total fee of \$15 covers complete board, room and tuition costs.
