In addition to watching or participating in the floor hockey scrimmage, FTC students received souvenir

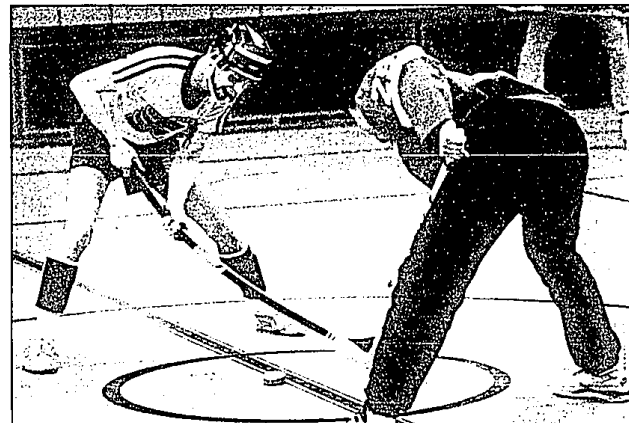
buttons, T-shirts, autographs and door prizes.

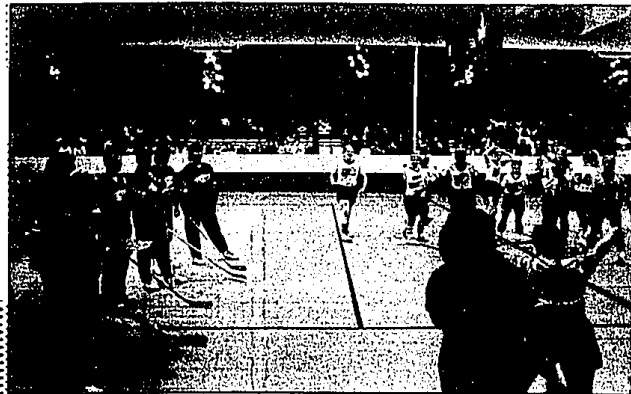
Joe Kocur of the Red Wings is introduced before the scrimmage at the Farmington Training Center.



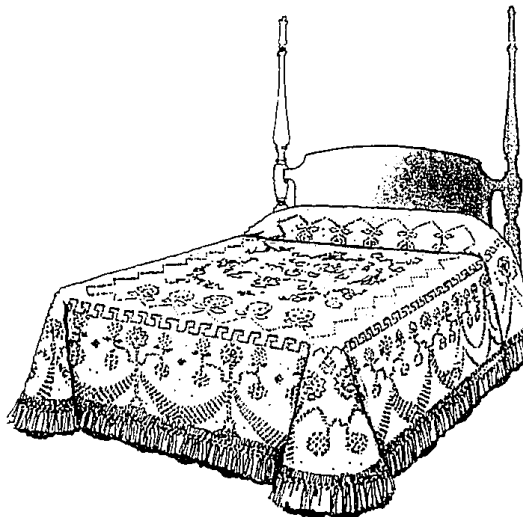
