**police/fire calls**

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week:

● **LOCKER FIRE**  
Minimal damage was reported after a locker fire at Farmington High School Monday.  
The blaze, reported to Farmington public safety officers at about 5:40 p.m., sent a moderate amount of smoke floating through the halls of the school. According to reports, a notebook on the top shelf of a locker in hall "G" was apparently set on fire. Public safety officers removed it and put it in a bucket of water. The locker was apparently not locked.

● **ASSAULT ARREST**  
A 28-year-old Redford Township man was arrested and charged with assault and battery after allegedly picking a fight with an off-duty police officer from Farmington Hills Feb. 7.  
The incident occurred at about 1

a.m. at Green's Hamburgers, 34155 Orchard Lake Road, Farmington. According to a Farmington Department of Public Safety report, the subject started becoming argumentative, and when the officer attempted to calm him, the man began pushing at the officer's chest.
