"I liked how the people of Farmington gave things to the mansion to

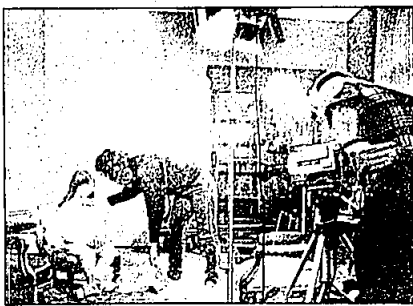
help refurbish it," he said. "It's a historical spot in Farmington, and a nice place to visit."

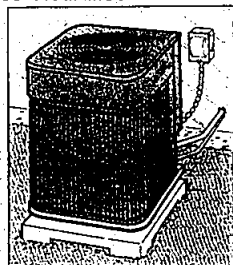

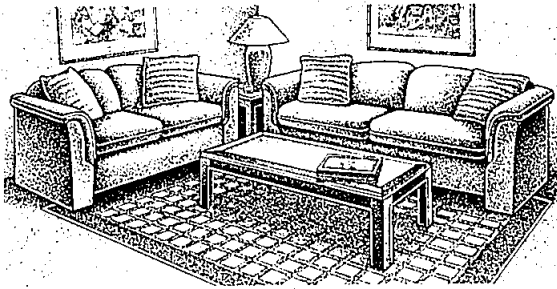
