## POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

### ■ ASSAULT AND BATTERY

Two boys, ages 10 and 11, were tossing rocks in front of an Alice Key address Aug. 1. One of the rocks struck a grey/blue Jaguar as it drove by, Farmington Hills police said. A man, described as being in his late 20s with reddish blond hair, thin build and wearing a blue tanktop shirt, exited the car. He caught the 11 year old under a bush and grabbed him forcefully from behind, around his neck with both hands, the police report said. The suspect pulled the boy out of the bush and grabbed him by the left arm up to a residence. The suspect reportedly yelled: "Don't you know what kind of car this is? We're going to speak to you parents now." When the boy was brought up to the house, a woman there said that it wasn't her son. He then released the boy. The man left and the woman called police.

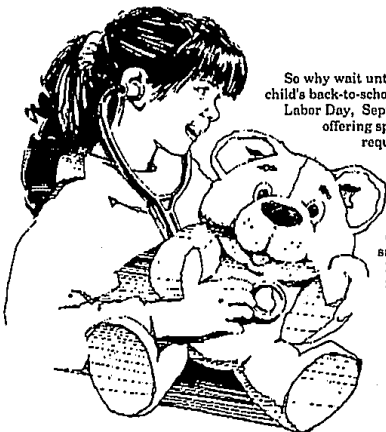
