**NOTICE OF INTENTION OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS TO ENTER INTO A FULL FAITH AND CREDIT GENERAL OBLIGATION CONTRACT OF LEASE WITH THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS BUILDING AUTHORITY AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REFERENDUM**

TO ALL ELECTORS AND TAXPAYERS OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, intends to enter into a full faith and credit general obligation contract of lease with the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority. The contract of lease will provide, among other things, for the construction and expansion by the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority of Fire Station No. 2 located at 28223 Middlebelt Road in the City of Farmington Hills. The contract of lease also will provide that the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority will finance the cost of the project by the issuance of building authority bonds pursuant to the provisions of Act 31, Public Acts of Michigan, 1948 (First Extra Session), as amended, in anticipation of the receipt of cash rental payments to be made by the City of Farmington Hills to the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority pursuant to the contract of lease. The maximum principal amount of bonds to be issued is \$1,100,000.

**FULL FAITH AND CREDIT AND LIMITED TAXING POWER OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS PLEDGED**

In the contract of lease the City of Farmington Hills will obligate itself to make cash rental payments to the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority in amounts sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds to be issued by the City of Farmington Hills Building Authority, and the full faith and credit of the City of Farmington Hills will be pledged for the making of the cash rental payments as a limited tax first budget obligation. Pursuant to the pledge of its full faith and credit, the City of Farmington Hills will be required in each year to include in its general fund budget and to appropriate such amounts as shall be necessary to make the cash rental payments. In no event may the City of Farmington Hills levy ad valorem taxes for the purpose of making the cash rental payments at a rate in excess of the rate permitted by law. In addition to rental payments at a rate in excess of the rate permitted by law, the City of Farmington Hills will agree in the contract of lease to pay all costs and expenses of the Authority incidental to the issuance and payment of the bonds to the extent such expenses are not payable from the proceeds of the bonds and to provide for the payment of the expenses of operating and maintaining the project.

**RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REFERENDUM**

This notice is given to and for the benefit of the electors and taxpayers of the City of Farmington Hills, in order to inform them that the City Council has authorized the execution of the above described contract of lease and also to inform them of their right to petition for a referendum on the question of entering into the contract of lease. The City of Farmington Hills intends to enter into the contract of lease without a vote of the electors thereon, but the contract of lease shall not become effective until 45 days after publication of this notice. If, within said 45-day period, a petition for referendum requesting an election on it, signed by not less than 10% or 15,000 of the registered electors of the City of Farmington Hills, whichever is less, has been filed with the City Clerk, the contract of lease shall not become effective unless approved by a majority of the electors of the City of Farmington Hills voting thereon at a general or special election.
