A landfill closed in the 1960s occupies 23 acres on the southwest corner of the development. Brock said roughly two-thirds needs to be capped to meet state environmental regulations. Brock said the capping could add \$1.5 million to the project cost.

City officials will seek to reduce costs through state brownfield redevelopment legislation, which allows developers of land suspected to be contaminated to seek tax relief.

San Marino Golf Course is the only Farmington Hills-owned golf course. Glen Oaks is owned by Oakland County and Copper Creek is privately owned.

Brock said the city is pursuing

rates for residents, juniors and seniors.

In the shade of the San Marino clubhouse on Tuesday, Larry Farrugia of Highland, seated in a golf cart, said a course expansion "would be great." He said the current course "looks easy but it's tough, it's a nice course."

Farrugia, who plays San Marino every Tuesday, said the present nine doesn't seem crowded.

"If they had 18 I'd play more," said Al Rosenberg of Farmington Hills, also on the course Tuesday morning as the temperature approached 90 degrees.

"I love the idea of expanding to 18," said Olga Savo of Farmington Hills, as she left the course after playing nine holes.
