Trust Yourself

We have all had the experience of listening to the advice of others and then following it even though it just didn't feel right to us. Sometimes we know in our heart of hearts what we really should do, but the pressure of others so forcefully exerts itself that we ignore that little voice within us. And although most of us have the capacity to solve our own problems with a combination of reasoning and listening to what our own feelings and conscience are telling us; perhaps the reason we so often listen to others and ignore our own best judgment is that it is easier to hear the clamor of other voices than it is to hear our own. It takes patience and solitude to hear the voice within us, but with practice, and the courage to go against the crowd, we can learn to trust ourselves and make our own decisions about the things that really matter to us. And even if we make a few mistakes, it is far better to make our own mistakes and have them truly be ours than to listen to what others tell us to do, and in effect, live someone else's life. Remember that conscience is the voice of God within us, but we often can't hear this voice because we aren't listening.
