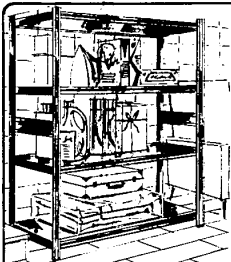

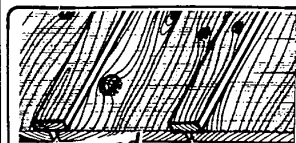

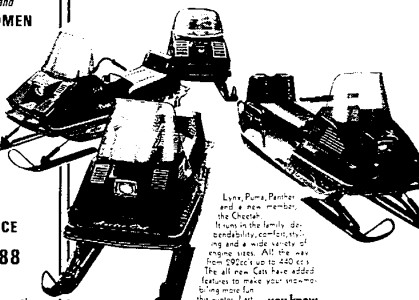

## Consumers Council Opened

The mobile home and recreational vehicle industry in Michigan began the new year by establishing a Consumer Relations Council to regulate the industry.

Consumers with a complaint against a business may write to: Mrs. Alice White, director of the Consumer Relations Council, Michigan Mobile Home and Recreational Vehicle Institute, 19045 Farmington Rd., Livonia 48152.

She will send a form to the consumer which should be returned to the Council.

A copy of the complaint will be sent to the business, and the business will be asked to report back to the council. A quarterly analysis of the case files will be conducted by the council to see if any business has an unusual number of unresolved complaints.

In such a case, the board of directors will take remedial action.

## Immigrant Information Confidential

Information furnished by an alien in making his annual address report to the government is confidential.

According to Thomas M. Pederson of the Detroit Immigration and Naturalization office, the information furnished by aliens in reporting their address has been declared confidential by statute.

These reports must be submitted during January each year by all aliens in the United States, with few exceptions. Forms on which to submit the reports are available at any Post Office or office of the Immigration and Naturalization Service.

Persons who are unable to pick up a form because of illness, or other reasons, may have a relative or friend obtain a card for them.

The card should be returned to one of these offices.

Parents or guardians of aliens under 14 years of age must submit reports for such children.

## Any Kids For Kindergarten?

All Clarensville residents will be receiving a stamped, self-addressed postal card requesting information concerning eligible kindergarten children and children not yet enrolled in school for the 1972-73 school year.

Mrs. Patricia J. Vickery, elementary consultant, urges that parents of youngsters to be enrolled in school return the postal cards as early as possible.
