Voters To Act On Three Proposals; Two Board Members

Three important proposals will also be voted upon by the people in the July 8 school election. The first is a proposal to levy a five mill tax to assess a portion of property in the school district for a period of five years, in order to create a sinking fund for the construction and repair of school buildings, and to the present building and Site Fund. The second proposal is to allow property owners or the lawful husband or wife of such owner are eligible to vote on this question. A third proposal is required to pass this proposal...

Voters To Act On Three Proposals; Two Board Members

A second proposal to be voted upon in the July 8 election would permit the exceeding of the 15 mill tax limit established by state law. Unless this proposal is approved it will be impossible to levy five mills for the Building and Site Fund. This proposal requires a two thirds majority to pass. All registered voters in the school district are eligible to vote on this issue. The proposal to adopt Teacher Tenure in the Farmington Township School District is also on the ballot. This proposal was instituted by the Farmington Board of Education.
