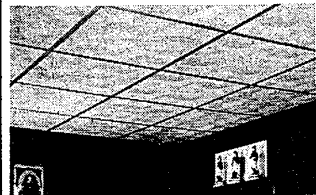

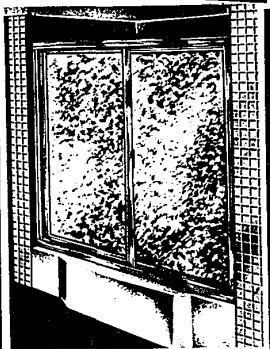

ESP Course At Oakland

Due to the burgeoning interest in psychic research, two courses in extrasensory perception will be repeated starting April 8 at University Center for Adult Education (WSU - UM).

"ESP Today" was first offered last fall. The response was so enthusiastic that an advanced course, "ESP and the Psychic Self" was added to the spring term, which began in February.

Taught by Dale Cottrill, Ph.D., the introductory course includes lectures, discussions and demonstrations synthesizing the research about extrasensory perception and examining alpha - genes, hypnosis, sleep and dreams, perception, desire, memory, visualization, clairvoyants, reincarnation, witchcraft, occultism and control systems.

The advanced course continues this method of study and delves into classic methods of psychic investigation, with the student learning to organize his own approach.

Both eight week courses meet on Saturdays. "ESP Today" meets from 12 noon to 2 p.m. and "ESP and the Psychic Self" meets 2:15 to 4:15 p.m.

Classes are open to all interested adults. Tuition for the beginning course is \$32. The advanced course is \$35. Reduced fees are available to married couples and senior citizens.
