

Township Begins Spring Tree Sale

FARMINGTON
Orders are now being taken for trees being sold by the Township of Farmington Beautification Committee as it begins its annual spring tree planting program.

Six species of trees are being offered at prices from \$12 to \$19. All trees are being purchased from Steinkopf Nursery of Farmington and can be delivered to residents or picked up at Farmington Township Hall, 31555 W. 11 Mile.

The \$12 trees being sold include: Silver maple, 8-10 feet tall with 1 1/2 inch girth, grows in most soil conditions; honey locust, eight feet tall, 1 1/4 inch girth, grows in most soil conditions; and sweet gum, five to six feet tall, well branched, and grows in well-drained soil.

The \$14 trees are: Norway maple, 8-10 feet tall, one to 1 1/2 inch girth, grows in sandy, well-drained soil;

and Marshall ash, 8-10 feet tall, one and 1/2 inch girth, grows in most conditions.

The Crimson King tree sells for \$19, comes 8-10 feet tall with one to 1 1/2 inch girth and grows well in sandy, well-drained soil.

All trees will be potted, balled or burlaped. The nursery will not plant any of the trees and, for the above prices, there will be no guarantees.

A delivery charge of \$1.50 per tree is made if delivered to the purchaser's home, although delivery is free if five or more trees are ordered.

Trees not delivered to residents will be available for pickup at the township parking lot on Friday, April 28, and Saturday, April 29.

Checks should be made payable to Township of Farmington and orders placed promptly because deadline for orders is April 20.

budget which was allocated to be spent in Farmington Township. That was enough money to help remove or control the tides of Kenwood Lake, but the year ended, and the "surplus" was taken away from the township and placed into the county's general fund. (Money allocated by the county to the township but unspent at year's end is taken away - the county givesh and the county takesh away).

Apparently the township has tried to fix the system but it seems everyone involved is having his share of problems. Teeples said: "we started

pumping out the water last year, but there is a blockage in the drain." He went on to say that "the present system is old and out of date and should be replaced."


Teeples admitted "this is over and above a normal problem (for residents of the area), and the county should appropriate funds for the repairs."

Then he revealed that township engineers have been assigned to do a study for the entire drainage condition for that area. Teeples also said that June 1 is the starting date for a ditching project along the northern portion of the plagued street.

MEANWHILE, Wendow and other affected businessmen watch the water as it closes off their driveways and parking areas.

John Gabrys, owner of Kenwood Garage, located on the other side of the "lake," has a similar problem. As he sidestepped along the edge of his water-logged property, he said:
