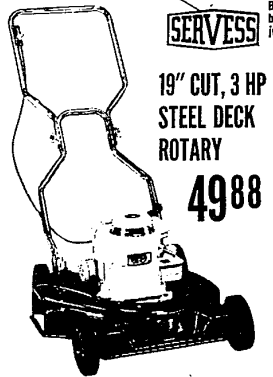

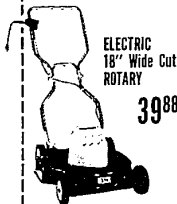

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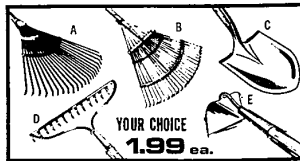

Farmington Public School District, Oakland County, Michigan, proposes to sell a parcel of real estate with improvements thereon, hereinafter described upon the following terms and conditions:

- Should the bidder desire terms other than the bid price being payable within 20 days after delivery by the School District of a Title Commitment in the amount of the purchase price showing marketable title on the School District, such terms must be specified with the bid.
