File Proposed Zoning Changes

Copies of three proposed amendments to the Township Zoning Ordinance have been forwarded to the chairman of the Zoning Board for consideration and public hearing. Harry McCracken, Township Clerk, reported this week.

The first proposal concerns the rezoning from Residential to Light Industrial of a section of land on the northeast corner of Farmington Road and Eight Mile Road. The property involved includes an acre with a radius of 1,200 feet and an acre length of 1,500 feet. The second proposal includes a parcel of land on the northwest corner of Twelve Mile Road and Drake Road which would be rezoned from Residential to Commercial. The parcel covers 308 feet along the north side of Twelve Mile Road and 330 feet along the west side of Drake Road.

The third proposed change from Residential to Commercial concerns a parcel of land approximately 600 feet south of Orchard Lake Road and west of Orchard Lake Road. The area includes 1,340 feet along Orchard Lake Road with a depth of 300 feet.

Grouse Broods Larger But Birds Still Scarce

Scattered individual reports and a general Conservation Department survey both indicate ruffed grouse broods sizes are larger than usual this year.

But state game men hasten to add that little change is expected this fall from last year's low ebb in hunting. Though broods are bigger, birds still seem to be at a low point in their 10-year population cycle. The average size is seven or eight birds per brood.

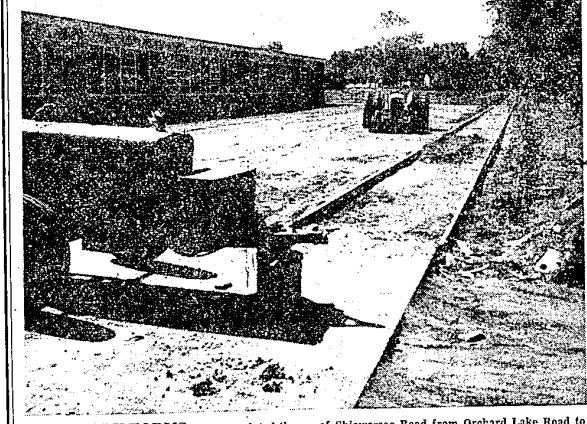

WOODEN BEARINGS

Equipped with the latest word in electronic gadgets, the Navy's submarines nevertheless have wooden bearings on their propeller shafts. Reason is that since the bearings are submerged at all times, there's no way of lubrication except from the water itself. Bearings are made of lignum vitae, hard tropical wood.

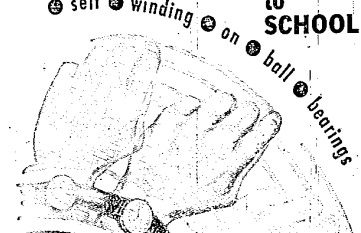
