Haiti Missionary To Speak Here

Appearing at the First Baptist Church of Farmington soon will be the well-known Mrs. Holdeman, missionary for over 20 years for the people of Haiti.

Mrs. Holdeman is a graduate of Nyack Missionary Training School in Nyack, New York, and has taken nurse's training in Toronto, Canada. Her story is especially unusual in that after raising her family, she became a missionary in Haiti, laboring in the Department of La Platte and the Department of Anse Rouge.

Going to that country entirely on faith with the salary of \$20 per month given to her by some friends in this country, she lived in a remote area, accessible only by boat, with the Haitians and as a Haitian, earning the love and respect of that people and government in that after raising her family, she became a missionary in Haiti, laboring in the Department of La Platte and the Department of Anse Rouge.

She will speak in the Detroit area from May 9 through May 13. She will speak on needs in Haiti and those especially resulting from the destruction dealt by "Hurricane Hazel" a short time ago.
