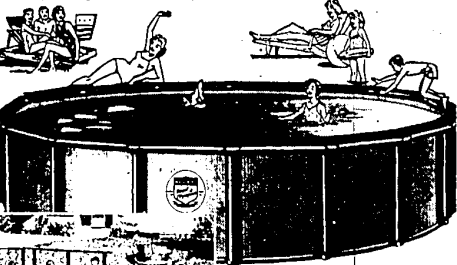

The school newspaper and editor were cited for winning national and state honors in the 1966 School Press Project which was conducted throughout the nation.

Dan and the other editors toured the State Journal, where they saw how a large daily newspaper is printed.

During lunch at the Lansing Press Club, they received their winning certificates.

Afterwards they were taken on a tour of the State Capitol where they were introduced in both the House of Representatives and the Senate.

Kenneth Watson, advisor, accompanied Dan on the trip.

The School Press Project is sponsored annually by the Columbia Scholastic Press Association, the National Tuberculosis Association and its local affiliates including the TB and Health Society, Wayne County's Christmas Seal agency.

Purpose is to encourage young people to become interested in medical science reporting and to increase the knowledge of students of the threat of their health from tuberculosis and other respiratory diseases. The project is open to both senior and junior high school newspapers.
