Township Redraws Precincts Once Again

The year's second juggling of precinct boundary lines in Farmington Township has been necessitated by the newly court-approved map of Oakland County supervisor districts, it was announced this week.

To make local boundaries coincide with county district borders, new designations have been given sections 6, 7, 11, 18 and part of 19, said Township Clerk Floyd Cairns.

He explained that Sections 6, 7, 18 and the part of 19 which lie north of I-96 have been attached to Precinct 7, voting

at O. E. Dunkel Junior High School.

The western half of Section 11 will become part of Precinct 11, voting at North Farmington High School. The eastern half of Section 11 has been attached to Precinct 16, voting at Fairview School.

The changes take effect with the Aug. 6 primary and will apply also to the Nov. 5 general election. Officials anticipate that because of the township's steadily rising population another redrawing of pre-

dict boundary lines will be necessary before the 1970 biennial election.

Approximately 700 voters live in the sections given new designations in the latest revision and all have been notified of the switch by mail, said Cairns.

A peculiarity of the situation forces residents of Section 11 to go out of their own neighborhood to cast ballots, while the voting site for residents of Precinct 3 remains Highmeadow School—located in the heart of Section 11.

Romney Vetoes Airport Vote Bill

A bill which would have required a county-wide referendum on the expansion of the Oakland County Airport at Orion has been vetoed by Governor Romney.

In vetoing the measure the Governor called it an "unjustified and potentially disastrous restriction on the future development of air transportation in the metropolitan area of our state."

"It is no secret," the Governor continued, "that the only county immediately within the population standards of this amendment is Oakland County, which has airport facilities now totaling 599.2 acres."

THE BILL would have required that a referendum be called in any county that wanted to expand an airport beyond 600 acres.

State Representative Donald E. Blalock (R., Rochester) guided the measure through the House. He said that he backed the bill because many residents in his area had written to him opposing the proposed facility.

The measure was passed by the House by a single vote, while the Senate approved it 34-0. In order to override Romney's veto it needs a two-thirds majority vote in each house.

Oakland County plans to expand the airport to complement the Waterford Township. A master plan is now before the Federal Aviation Agency, and if approval is forthcoming quickly, some phases of construction could start at Oakland-Orion early next year.

ROMNEY'S message asserted that "We cannot afford ill-conceived limitations on the mobility of public decision making in this growing increasingly essential transportation field."

"The public is entitled to checks and balances but they now exist in this field through the elected governmental officials responsible for such airport expansion and through the federal, state and local funds upon which such development is dependent."
