Supporters of an Aug. 6 Wayne County tax proposal are adding a concerned tone to their talks and articles.

Wayne County Tax Proposal 'Crucial'

This is apparent in a recent letter from Judge James H. Lincoln of the Probate Court's Juvenile Division, Lincoln is chairman of a committee supporting the tax proposal.

The proposal is to renew for five more years a one-mill property tax that was voted five years ago for Wayne County operations.

In a letter this week, Lincoln said:

"BECAUSE OF ITS crucial public importance, I most earnestly solicit your support for County Proposition No. 1, which will be on the ballot for the Aug. 6 primary election in Wayne County.

"Proposition No. 1, placed on the ballot by the County Board of Supervisors, seeks to continue for an additional five years a one-mill property levy (\$1 per \$1,000 of equalized valuation) which was adopted by the voters in 1964 for a five-year period. Thus it is not a tax increase.

"Approval of Proposition No. 1 is absolutely essential to prevent disastrous cutbacks in many of the most vital public services provided by Wayne County for its 2.7-million residents. The levy is costing the average homeowner only about 50 cents a month (based on an estimated market value of \$12,000 for the average home). But it produces approximately \$9.5-million annually to meet pressing human needs.

"Revenue from the one mill helps to support county programs in the fields of hospital care, public health, child care, juvenile delinquency, mental health, law enforcement, the courts, education, library services, and parks and recreation. Failure of County Proposition No. 1 would force drastic reductions in all these activities.

"SUCH CUTBACKS would imperil the health, safety and well-being of every resident of Wayne County because county programs are already operating at the bare minimum due to the shortage of funds even with the one mill.

"For example, I know all too well from personal observation that many juvenile delinquents capable of serious crimes are roaming our streets, unsupervised, due to my court's lack of staff and space. The people of Wayne County are not getting the services necessary to curb de-

linquency or to handle neglect cases. Failure of County Proposition No. 1 would result in an even greater shortage of court personnel.

"Similar shortages exist throughout county government in spite of the best efforts of county officials to achieve long-term solutions to the fi-

nanial problems of the county.

"County Proposition No. 1 has been endorsed by the Greater Detroit Board of Commerce, the Wayne County AFL-CIO Council, the Metropolitan Detroit Council of Churches, the Catholic Charities, the Jewish Community Council, United Community Services of Metro-

politan Detroit and numerous city councils and township boards in Wayne County.

"In the interests of sound public services and a better community, I urge you to add your influential voice to those that are supporting County Proposition No. 1," Lincoln said.
