

LBJ Tells Hanoi 'Won't Sit, Watch GIs Killed'

WASHINGTON -- President Johnson has strongly indicated to Hanoi that he will not sit by and watch American GIs get killed. He told reporters that he had "every reason to believe" that the Viet Cong are getting ready for a "massive attack" on allied and South Vietnamese forces.

In the same news conference Johnson added there had not been, up to that point, any change in America's bombing halt. He also said the levels of enemy infiltration are at an all-time

peak.

PARIS -- In response to a press conference by Secretary of State Dean Rusk, a North Vietnamese ambassador said it was only another indication of the "obduracy of the US aggressive ruling circles" and added that the US officials are lying when they report troop build-up by Communists.

Rusk had asked the North Vietnamese what steps it would take to reduce the fighting if the US ceased all attacks on

its territory.

World Roundup

-- In defense of his encyclical banning use of any artificial contraceptives by Catholics, Pope Paul VI told more

than 1,000 persons that it had not been an easy decision and he was "touched" by the anxiety of the persons who were troubled by the problem of birth control.

CIERNA NAD TISOU, Czechoslovakia -- In guarded optimism, Czech leaders Alexander Dubcek and Josef Smrkovsky said there had been "some success" in their talks with Soviet leaders.

Moscow-based reports indicated that the Soviet line against

Czechoslovakia is softening and the anti-aircraft phase of the Soviet war games over Czech soil are ended.

MEXICO CITY -- Rioting continued here as gangs of youths ran wild through the city. Police in two busloads were sent in and the mobs withdrew. The mobs had hijacked four city buses and crashed them into the sides of buildings.

SAIGON -- Combined efforts of armed American gunboats,

helicopter gunships and South Vietnamese marines forged into the thick Mekong Delta area and carried out a raid on a Viet Cong base camp.

The allied marines reported taking 62 weapons, 423 mortar rounds and more than 12,000 rounds of ammunition. There were no allied fatalities but two South Vietnamese marines were wounded.

SEOUL -- One American and one Korean were killed in a clash last week along the sep-

arating demilitarized zone in Korea.

A military spokesman said the US 2nd Infantry Division patrol met-up with North Korean infiltrators near the neutral zone and opened fire. Three Americans were wounded.

PRAGUE -- Gen. Samuel Kodan, a Czech officer opposed to Dubcek's liberal reforms, reportedly has been in contact with Soviet officers. According to the Czech paper, Prace, a trade-union publication, the

meetings were to "exchange views on the present situation."

Kodan warned last month against Czechoslovakia's planned "counter-revolutionary" tendencies.

BANGKOK, Thailand -- Resulting from the alleged North Vietnamese-inspired attack on the US Air Force base at Udorn, the Thai government is relocating some of the 40,000 North Vietnamese refugees to southern Thailand.

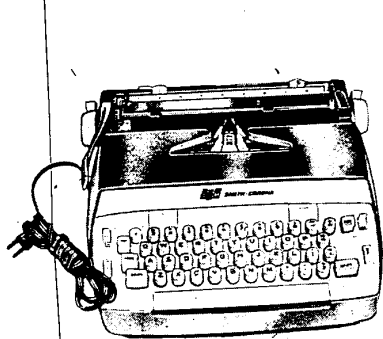

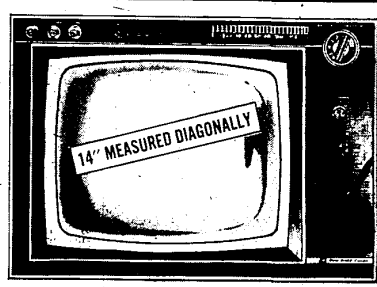

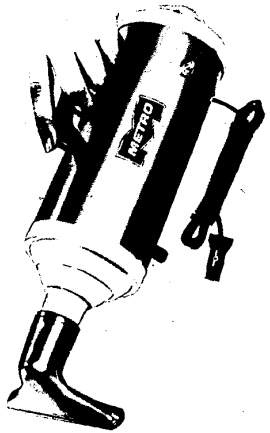
