Madonna offers testing to spot learning problems

Children who are performing poorly in school will have an opportunity for free educational testing at Madonna College.

Offered by the education and psychology department, the testing will take place as part of a classroom laboratory of upper level teacher education students.

Supervision will be provided by Dr. June J. Stodolnik, department chairman, Robert O. Stutler, and George Graham, instructors in the education psychology department.

Testing will reveal why children are having problems with language, reading, remembering or finishing assignments," Stutler said.

Madonna students, most of whom are studying for specialization in learning disabilities, will then prescribe remedial techniques which parents or teachers may employ to assist the child.

Children selected for testing should be in either the fourth, fifth or sixth grades. They will be expected to attend six sessions at Madonna, 3000 Schoolcraft, Livonia, on alternate Saturdays from 10:30 to noon, beginning Feb. 1.

"Madonna students will benefit from their direct contact with children of varying capabilities," said Sr. Mary Martina, director of the college's psycho-education center, "and children and parents will benefit from a thoroughly supervised professional diagnosis."

Remedial techniques which may assist the child will be recommended to the parents, but there will be no official communication between the college and the child's teacher, she added.

Parents who would like their children to participate in the testing should call the education department at Madonna College for a pre-registration form. There will be a minimum fee to cover cost of materials. Twenty children will be accepted for testing.
