

# Getting Around

The Coopers Arms, one of the most popular restaurants in Rochester, is expanding with a new pub and entertainment room opening Wednesday. Premiere attraction in the Coopers Pub will be the Tinkers Dam, a folk-singing duo who were both born in Ireland. The two have performed mostly on the eastern seaboard, throughout the midwest and in Canada, according to Pat Burke, wife of guitarist Marty Burke. His partner is Roger Redmond of Westland.

Mrs. Burke said a fire in Pittsburgh did them out of a recent booking there, and the Tinkers Dam returned to this area for a two-week substitute engagement at the Red Nose Tavern in Commerce Township.

"It's the first time they have been back in the Detroit area in a year, although we live here," she said. Mrs. Burke said she travels with her husband and their two children in a 25-foot motor home in the summer.

"We pick up and go on the road," she said. "The Tinkers Dam—in case you give a—will play their own happy music, old banjo, Hungarian fiddle and assorted other unusual acoustic instruments—at the pub for six weeks through the end of February. The nationally known pair sings both Irish and American folk songs.

The Coopers Pub will offer live music five nights a week in an atmosphere featuring stained glass decor. The room will seat more than 100 per-

sons, in a balcony area and on ground level, with the stage at intermediate height.

Showtime will be from 8 p.m. to 1 a.m. Tuesday through Thursday and 9 p.m. to 2 a.m. Friday and Saturday. A minimal cover will be charged persons who don't dine in the Carpenters Room or the Courage Taproom beforehand, restaurant owner Rober Krupp said.

Days, the pub will be open for lunch. Unusual recorded music on an antique jukebox is promised.

ANOTHER LOCAL boy who has made good, young vocalist Bob Anderson is in town for a showdate at the Golden Coach in Warren. Anderson's fans have seen him perform in Las Vegas shows starring Nancy Sinatra and Joan Rivers.

He also has charmed the female contingent who viewed his handsome face and muscular chest in Cosmopolitan magazine, which named him a Bachelor of the Month. Anderson keeps an apartment in Rochester, although he plans to spend most of his time in Vegas.

The singer and impressionist

opened a two-week engagement Tuesday at the Golden Coach. There is a cover charge. In his early days Anderson sang in the Detroit area with Sandra Mondella.

Paul Anka is among the celebrities who have praised Anderson, calling him "the best new singer in years."

AT PETTER'S PLACE, a restaurant in Avon Township, folksinger Larry McLean continues as the night-time attraction Wednesdays through Saturdays starting at 9 p.m.

McLean has been playing there for four or five months, according to restaurant owner Steve Petter of Rochester.

"He sounds a lot like John Denver and sings a lot of his songs," Petter said. There is no cover charge for entertainment.

Petter also has another restaurant, The Dugout in Clearwater, Fla. Both during spots from Italian menus. Petter has lived in the Rochester area for 11 years and opened Petter's Place about a year ago.

Petter built the restaurant himself with an English decor because "I like it." The setting is casual, and you can order everything "from steak to spaghetti, to chicken and shrimp, plus Italian dishes," he said.

It's located in the Campus Corners Shopping Center.
