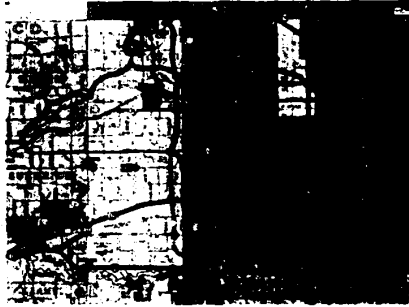

Freeway's end in sight

Most I-96 freeway projects are scheduled for completion by the end of the 1976 construction season, according to the Michigan State Highways and Transportation Department. This includes (1) the Haggerty corridor from Now to Schoolcraft; (2) the Schoolcraft segment from Haggerty to Telegraph; and (3) the Schoolcraft segment east of the M-39 freeway (Southfield Road). Scheduled for completion in 1977 or 1978 is (4) the segment from Telegraph to Southfield roads. M-14 freeway from Ann Arbor to I-96 in Livonia is scheduled for completion by the end of the 1977 construction season. Work started last year on (5) the Washtenaw County segment, and work will begin this year on (6) the Wayne County segment in the Plymouth area. I-275 will be completed in 1976 from I-94 near Metropolitan Airport to I-75 in Monroe County (7). The final link (8) from M-153 (Ford Road) in Canton Township to I-94 is scheduled to be done in 1977. Construction contracts are written in work days, because contractors are at the mercy of the weather.

U-M real estate courses offered at Rackham

Two courses of interest to both professional and novice in real estate will be offered in Detroit this winter by the University of Michigan real estate program. Real Estate Business I, an introductory course, and Real Estate Selling Methods Workshop, both will begin the week of Feb. 9 at Rackham Educational Memorial, 60 Farnsworth at Woodward. The U-M real estate program is presented by the U-M Extension Service and Graduate School of Business Administration. Now in its 29th year, the program has served as a model for others throughout the country. It awards to students who complete eight courses the U-M certificate in real estate. The certificate is approved by the National Association of Realtors and Michigan Association of Realtors as meeting academic qualification toward the Graduate, Realtors Institute (GRI) designation. Real Estate Business I, to be taught by Kenneth W. Lieber, Allen Park realtor and attorney, offers a practical approach to problems arising in real estate transactions. Don Wardell, lecturer in the U-M real estate program, will be instructor for Real Estate Selling Methods Workshop, a course designed to increase the efficiency of sales personnel.
