## Suspects arraigned in robbery case

Two men charged with the Dec. 30 armed robbery of Howard's Beauty Supply in Farmington were bound over to Oakland County Circuit Court Friday, Jan. 30, following a preliminary hearing before 47th District Court Judge Margaret Schaefer.

Edward J. Kelly, 35, Westland and Robert Boswell, 42, Detroit, are each charged with three counts of armed robbery.

According to Farmington police, the two persons entered the store and left with an estimated \$4,500 in cash and merchandise.

Boswell was arrested in Detroit by detectives Murry Senter and Tom Daniels. He was arraigned Jan. 26 before Judge Schaefer and bond was set at \$100,000.

Kelly was picked up by officers from the Pontiac State Police post on a warrant issued by Farmington. He was arraigned Jan. 15 and bond was set at \$50,000.

Both men remain in police custody pending arraignment at 9 a.m. Tuesday, Feb. 17 in Oakland County Circuit Court.
