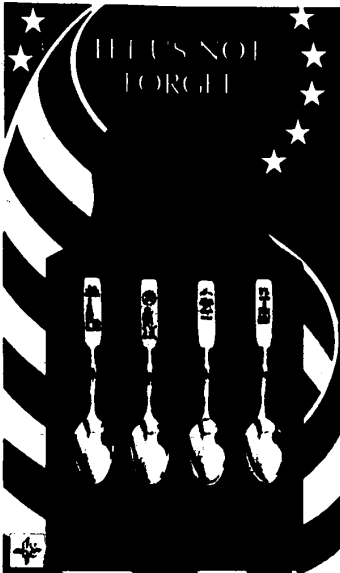

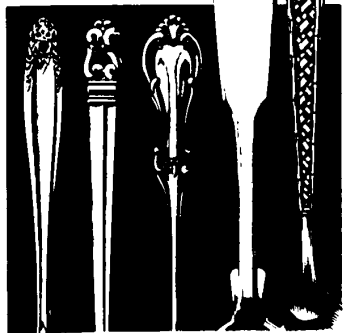

Colonial Dames set needlework show

Michigan members of the National Society of Colonial Dames in America will put on the group's second annual needlepoint show March 3-5 to raise funds toward refurbishing Whoby Hall in the Detroit Institute of Arts.

Women interested in entering one of the categories, including needlepoint, embroidery, crewel, applique, quilting, Rya rug or hooked rugs, should pick up blanks at local needlework stores. The deadline for listing an entry is Feb. 11. Judges for the show will include Hope Hansley, author of the book, "Needlepoint," a recently-revised authoritative work on this type of needlework, who will fly in from Virginia for the event.

Judging with her will be Mrs. Gerald T. White of Trenton, national board member for the Embroiderers' Guild of America, and Sheila K. Tabakoff, associate curator of European decorative arts for the Detroit Institute.

Sponsoring the show is a bicentennial project for the 17 state members of an organization which has as its objective collection and preservation of manuscripts, traditions and relics of historical value. The organization maintains its museums in throughout the country. Its Whoby Hall project involves giving new life to a house that was built in Philadelphia in 1754 and brought to the Detroit Institute of Arts in 1927.

Camp Fire candy sale extended
