

# Smith shines in Lathrup loss

Birmingham Groves had little trouble beating Southfield-Lathrup, 197.45, in a Metro Suburban Association swimming meet last Thursday, but Lathrup's Dave Smith made the loss a lot easier to take.

Smith, an outstanding junior, turned in a 53.9 in the 100-yard butterfly and beat Groves' standout Tim Quill by two-tenths of a second. Smith's clocking established pool and varsity records at Lathrup.

Lathrup coach Pete Bugin has high hopes for his fiercest for the rest of the season and in the state meet coming up in March.

"I really think Smith is going to drop some more before the state meet, maybe down around 51.5," Bugin said. "Every meet he's coming down more and easy just like he should. He's not being erratic; not going up and down."

Smith also swam on Lathrup's 200-yard medley relay, which finished second in a varsity record of 1:48.1. The rest of the relay: Dave Cowan, Scott Mansfield and Bill Dunn. Groves set a pool record in that event with a 1:41.9.

Mansfield won the 100 breaststroke in 1:07.5, and Dunn took the 100 freestyle in 1:15.

# Falcons win swimming meet

Farmington High has an up-and-coming young swimmer in Terry Inch.

Inch set a sophomore record by winning the 100-yard freestyle in 54.8 to help Farmington defeat Walled Lake Central, 115-47, in an Inter Lakes League meet last Thursday. For his efforts, Inch was named swimmer of the meet by Farmington coach Jack Merritt.

"Inch is working very hard," Merritt said. "He has good endurance. He just keeps the same time over and over. He's not that fast really, but he just keeps going."

Farmington won eight of the 11 events. Bill Glida won the diving with 108.10 points. Jim Pogor took the 100 back in 1:08.2, and Ron Reinke won the 50 freestyle in 34.5.

Earlier last week, Northville High defeated Farmington, 100-43, in a non-league meet. Farmington's 400 freestyle relay (Ken Gutowski, Reinke, Jeff Noren and Fred Beattie) won in 3:48.1. Northville's Mike Sullivan set a Falcon pool record in the 100 breaststroke with a 1:06.7 clocking.
