

Rev. Eberhard will speak at Jaycee Prayer Breakfast

Rev. David Eberhard, Detroit City Councilman, will be the guest speaker when the Farmington Jaycees hold its Prayer Breakfast in Batdorf Inn on Wednesday, March 16, from 7:30 a.m.

A special guest will be Joy English, a Farmington resident and recording artist connected with KJFF Productions.

In addition to her singing engagements, Miss English has lectured extensively, privately and for groups, on the cause of Christian womanhood and Christian ethics. She records for Scorpion Records.

She is volunteering her time to be the guest artist for the Jaycees' annual event.

REV. EBERHARD has been a Detroit City Councilman since 1980. As a minister, he serves Riverside Lutheran Church, an urban congregation on the lower east side of Detroit. Holy Trinity Polish Lutheran Church and River Towers parish.

He is director of the Riverside Civic Fund Inc. which includes the Inner City Community Clinic, two drug maintenance programs, the Riverside Day Care Center, the Riverside Food and Friendship program for the elderly, the Riverside Development Committee and the Riverside Businessmen.

THE OBJECTIVES of Jaycees, in part, is to "develop a spirit of genuine Americanism and civic interest." The breakfast is held as a community service and the tickets are priced to cover costs.

Admission of \$4 will be asked at the door. Reservations are not being accepted. Accommodations are planned for 200 persons.

Dr. Mercer returns from the Holy Lands

Dr. William Mercer, senior minister of Nardin Park United Methodist Church, has just returned from the Holy Land, and will share some of his experiences there during his Lenten sermons on Sunday mornings.

The sermon topics he's chosen are based on the theme "I Walked Today Where Jesus Walked." They are called "On the Mountain Tops," "In the Valleys," "Beside Still Waters," "In the Market Place" and "On a Hill Far Away."

On Palm Sunday, the sermon topic will be "A Master in Our Midst" and on Easter Sunday, "Waiting for the Sunrise." There will be two duplicate sermons on Easter Sunday, at 9:15 and 11 a.m. with special music offered by the sanctuary choir.

Two films are being offered at the church, one appropriate for the bicentennial year, and the other for the Lenten-Easter season. Sunday, March 21, at 7 p.m. the film "1776" will be shown and is open to the public. The film deals with the creation of America's governing policies and offers an informal picture of the leaders of the country in that period.

The second film, to be shown Sunday, April 11, at 7 p.m. is "Barabbas" starring Anthony Quinn, and is sponsored by the Challengers, a group of young adults in the church. The film narrates the period immediately after the crucifixion and Barabbas' life following his pardon by Pilate.

ANOTHER GROUP at the church is the Nardineers, a senior citizens club which meets twice a month on Wednesdays. The club members have a food coop and plan periodic trips, both short and distant.

The next trips on the agenda will be a tour of the University of Michigan campus and a short stay at Meadow Brook Hall.

The church is affiliated with the Farmington Larger Parish Council of United Methodist Churches, which is now sponsoring a series of mental health forums. Inquiries about the church or any of its programs will be taken by calling the church office, 476-8888.
