Fitness convention planned at college

Schoolcraft College will become a convention center soon, but it's doubtful there will be the kind of partying one usually associates with 250 to 300 conventioners. The President's Council on Physical Fit-

ness and Sports, headed by former astronaut James Lovell, will hold a clinic and seminar on the college campus May 6-8. It will draw visitors from a half dozen Great Lakes states to motels and hotels in Livonia, Farmington Hills and Plymouth.

"THERE ARE ONLY six councils like this in the country," said Dr. Marvin Gans, the college's director of physical education and athletics.

"It's fantastic that they picked a community college," he added. "Not only is Schoolcraft the site, but the national office of the council is planning to make a 16 mm film of some of the events for national distribution. Gans said five activities will be taking place simultaneously for 15-hour periods both days.

"FITNESS IS AGELESS" will be the title of the seminar on physical activity for older adults on May 6. Star attraction will be Bonnie Proffitt, TV exercise personality and author. Work shops will cover exercise and nutrition. The May 7-8 part of the clinic will be an in-service training program for physical educators, recreation leaders and students interested in the field. It will offer graduate credit from Central Michigan University.
