Four girl gymnasts from the Birmingham YMCA qualified for regional competition with their performances at a Northwest District Saturday and Sunday at Howell.

However, the meet was so poorly run that none of the girls plan on attending the regional event.

"It seems that they set up the district meet on the same day as two other state meets," Pat Landy, associate physical director in charge of gymnastics at the YMCA, said. "They couldn't find judges and the judges they finally got didn't know how to judge. They were incredibly slow and the girls were there until midnight one night."

Despite the handicaps, the Birmingham YMCA earned two team trophies along with many individual ribbons besides qualifying four girls for the regionals.

Birmingham finished first in the Class 2, 15 and older division, and second in the Class 3, 18 and 11 years old competition.

Jill McBride of Birmingham was fourth in the all-around competition of the Class

2, 18 and 11 years old competition. She finished fourth in the vaulting, fourth on the bars, fifth in floor exercise, and sixth on the balance beam. She qualified for the regionals with her performance.

Another regional qualifier was Southfield resident Marlene Cecile, who competed in the Class 2, 13 to 14 years old category. She earned 11th place in all-around with a sixth on the bars, 12th in floor exercise, and a 12th on the balance beam.

Debbie Steinberger of Oak Park, also qualified for regional competition in the Class 2, 15 and older division. She was fourth in the all-around rankings by virtue of a third on the balance beam, fourth in floor exercise, sixth on the bars, and a seventh in vaulting.

Bright Middle of Southfield was the fourth qualifier. She was fifth in the all-around standings of the Class 2, 15 and older division. She was fourth on the balance beam, fifth in floor exercise, fifth on the bars, and second in vaulting.

Bloomfield Hills resident, Kelly Moss turned in a fine performance in the Class 3, 18 and older division. She was first in the all-around with a second in floor exercise, first in vaulting, first on bars, and first on the balance beam.

Troy resident Jane Maran finished third in the all-around competition of the same class and age group. She was fourth on the balance beam, fifth in floor exercise, third on the bars, and second in vaulting.

Cathy Michaels also of Troy finished second in the all-around rankings of the Class 3, 18 and 11 years old grouping. She was sixth on the balance beam, first in floor exercise, and fourth on the bars.

A Pontiac resident Tracy Scott finished third in the all-around of the same division. She was tied for sixth in the floor exercise, second on the bars, and second in vaulting.
