Student Senate asks to bargain

New collective bargaining developments are sweeping the country and Jeff Stabenau, Schoolcraft Student Senate president, is bringing one of those developments closer to home.

Schoolcraft students should be recognized as a legitimate third party to collective bargaining at the school, Stabenau told the board at its March 24 meeting. He added that a board appointed ad hoc committee to respond to student concerns would be unacceptable to the senate.

Stabenau relayed students' appeals saying that "it's a frustrating feeling being the largest group on campus, and the only one not able to hold union cards."

"Without students, there would be no teachers and without teachers, there would be no college. A student's prerogative in decision making must be voiced through formal recognition of student bargaining units."

According to Stabenau, few colleges across the country have involved students in the bargaining process, but universities in Oregon and Montana have proved the plan successful.

AMONG THE issues Schoolcraft students feel are legitimate in contract negotiations are:

- Criteria and methods used in evaluating the quality of teaching.
- Student participation in hiring faculty.
- Student participation in academic planning and curriculum review processes.
- Salary.
- Diversity and frequency of course offerings.
- Grading policies.
- Academic calendar.
- Office hours and availability of faculty members for student consultation.
- Policies concerning student-faculty grievances.

It seems appropriate that the student senate should designate three representatives to meet and confer with the college bargaining unit and the Faculty Forum before collective bargaining," said Stabenau.

BOARD MEMBERS agree that the "third party pressure on a two-party process" should be considered, and establishing an ad hoc committee would be a gain at this point.

Board President Paul Kadish said trustees will listen and respond to students' recommendations through an ad hoc committee.

"This is a decision that neither the faculty or trustees can make for each other," said Kadish. "I agree a great deal of master contract results are imposed on students, and that an ad hoc committee will be a gain—not a slight."

Schoolcraft President C. Nelson Grote, who recently attended a conference in Ann Arbor on "Third-Party Pressure on a Two-Party Process," agreed with Stabenau's request for ground rules.
