NO WEEK would be complete without registering another big 600 series for Mary Mobacsi, the Livonia school teacher, who is running up one of the finest high scoring streaks in her career.

The former Queen came through with a 640 series Wednesday night in the Ladies' Meet at Pine Tree Bowl. This gave her third place behind "Sarcany" Walker who fired a 675 and Cora Fiebig who took runner-up honors with a 601.

ALWAYS NOTED for close finishes, the Wonderland Classic furnished another one this week when Jack Norton and Rich Hughes battled it out in a high scoring struggle. At the finish, both had broken the 700 barrier. Norton edged out a victory with a 725 on games of 244, 367 and 234, while Hughes opened with a 238, followed with 251 and closed with 213 for 704.

To help make it a big night, Norton's 725 gave his team, Radford Bowling Sales, the high series with a 2157.

The ladies also had a great time and three of them posted double century figures. Lucille McKay linked games of 128, 187 and 122 for a 437 to pace the house league and Dorothy Patniac landed right behind with a 404 on games of 280, 391 and 303.
