Farmington Hills' Traffic Bureau reported a 14 per cent increase in accidents and traffic violations during 1975 over previous year figures. As shown in the chart above, 14 traffic related deaths were recorded in the city last year while 881 persons were injured. Type A injuries are incapacitating. B requires the victim to seek medical attention and type C are minor injuries.

A registration fee of \$3 will be accepted the first class meeting. The commission is sponsoring the clinic in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources.

Persons from 12 to 16 years of age are prohibited by law from operating a boat powered by more than six horsepower unless they are directly supervised by an adult or unless they have a boating safety certificate indicating completion of an approved boating safety course.

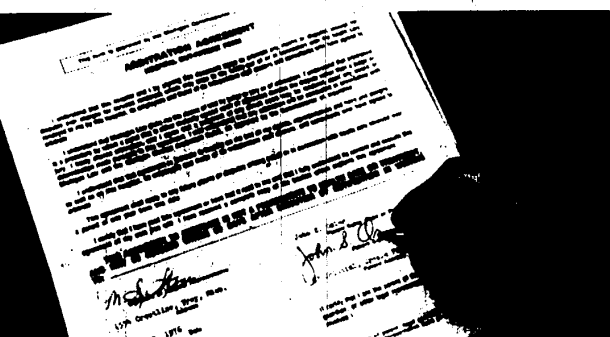
