## Nichols talks about women

Dr. Donald Nichols, dean of students at OCC's Orchard Ridge campus, outlined women's programs at public community colleges as guest speaker at the American Personnel Association meeting recently in Chicago.

Nichols presented statistics on staffing, financing and articulation as part of his research topic to the association.

"Colleges and universities across the country have expressed concern with the welfare of female students. Our research was designed to investigate what was being done by more than 1,100 two-year institutions," said Nichols, a Farmington resident.

Mary White and Peggy Orlich, Orchard Ridge counselors, worked with Nichols on a national survey of college needs which elicited responses on campus attitudes toward female students and special curricular offerings dealing with women in history and literature.

Responses to their survey indicated a

very high interest in the topic, Nichols said.

We are especially pleased with the work being done in our own Worcester at Orchard Ridge," he continued. "A variety of programs have been offered at the campus during the past year, and all of them are designed to deal with issues vital to women."

The ACPA convention was held in conjunction with the American Personnel and Guidance Association meeting and represents school, college and university counselors.

# Commission puts nix on busing referendum

The Michigan presidential primary will take place May 18, as scheduled, but the Oakland County "forced busing" question won't be on the ballot.

Reversing an action taken three weeks ago, the county board of commissioners Tuesday voted, 9-13 to kill the entire idea of holding a popular referendum on the volatile question of whether busing should be used as a court tool to achieve school integration.

Leading the effort to remove the question was Commissioner Robert Page (R-Birmingham), who changed his mind after voting to place the busing question on the ballot last month.

PAGE MOVED to reconsider the earlier action; then he soon as the reconsideration was under way, he moved to table the question—in effect, to kill it.

Page insisted "everyone has expressed opposition to forced busing," but school district lawyers argued the county board's decision to place the question on the ballot was "ill advised because it will have exactly the opposite effect of what we want."

By that, attorneys meant that supporters of busing would take the vote to be a segregationist act and use the act to argue for busing to achieve integration.

SUPPORTING TABLING the plan were

local Commissioners Dennis Murphy (R-Whitman), Fred Houghton (R-Rochester), Paul Kasper (R-Bloomfield Hills), Lillian McFitt (R-Bloomfield Township), John McDonald (R-Farmington Hills), Patrick Nowak (R-Farmington Hills) and Page.

Against tabling—and implicitly in favor of placing the question on the ballot—were Mary M. Dearborn (D-Birmingham), Henry Host (R-Troy), Chairman Alexander Perneck (D-Southfield) and Lawrence Perneck (D-Southfield).

Joseph Montanez (R-Orchard Lake) was absent.

Commissioner Betty Fortino (D-Pontiac), author of the busing ballot proposal, denounced those who favored tabling as "patience wasters" because "we've had a little pressure from some of our school boards."

Replied Page: "It's unfortunate we have these simplistic answers to complex questions."

Late in the meeting, Commissioner James Danvers (R-Highland) offered a resolution opposing "forced busing," but a quorum call quickly established that a majority of commissioners had either gone to the Tigers' opening game or simply didn't want to argue the issue any longer.

So when only five of 27 commissioners answered the quorum call, Chairman Perneck declared the meeting automatically adjourned.
