Bank gives away money to customers

The Farmington area's newest bank will give away money at its opening beginning at 9:30 a.m. Monday.

American Federal Savings will set \$10,000 in cash for \$7.85 when it opens the new office at Grand River and Halsted.

One of the bank's tellers will set \$8 new \$100 bills for \$80 each, 50 new \$50 bills for \$40 each, 75 new \$20 bills for \$18 each, 100 new \$10 bills for \$8 each, 100 new \$5 bills for \$4 each and 500 silver-clad bicentennial dollars for 50 cents each.

The money will be sold one bill or coin per family, on a first-come, first-served, cash-only basis.

Also participating in the ceremony will be Farmington Mayor John Richardson, who will cut a money "ribbon" which will be donated to the Farmington Community Band. O.H. Henry will accept the donation on the band's behalf.

American Federal Savings will be giving away money throughout the week-long celebration. Customers will receive a silver dollar for every \$1,000 deposited at the new branch, up to a maximum of 10 silver dollars.

Anyone may enter the grand prize contest by visiting the new branch and filling out a coupon. First prize is a \$1,000 passbook savings account; second prize is a \$750 passbook savings account and third prize is a \$500 passbook savings account.

Farmington, Farmington Hills and Novi area residents received a special direct-mail piece containing a key which may open the treasure chest at the branch. Owners of the keys will qualify for the drawing to award 20 prizes which include a TV, CB radio, man's and lady's watches.
