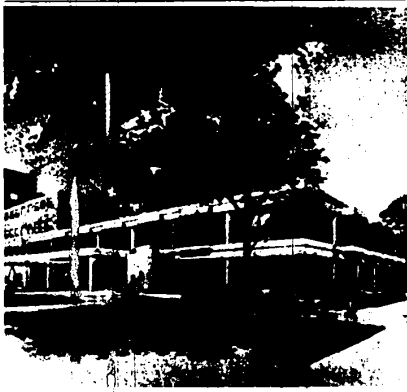

Construction begins on hospital addition

Construction was started in late March for a \$17.1 million expansion project for Providence Hospital in Southfield. Excavations will begin in May for the foundation of the new building designed to relieve the critical bed shortage that has plagued the hospital for several years.

The addition will be located south of the hospital and east of the Fisher Center. It will contain new intensive care and cardiac care units with 12 beds each and two 26-bed sections for medical-surgical patients.

The new building also will house an enlarged emergency department with the capability to serve 60,000 patients a year and an ambulatory care center to replace existing outpatient clinics. A new laboratory,

medical records library, respiratory therapy facility and an expanded outpatient surgery unit will be included.

Completion of the addition, scheduled for early 1978, will include a new laundry building and an enlargement of the powerhouse. Space freed in the existing hospital will be utilized for the expansion of operating room support areas, radiology and nuclear medicine, rehabilitation services, kitchen and dietary services and other departments.

The structure was designed by Detroit architects of Giffels Associates Inc., assisted by Stone, Mirracchini and Patterson of San Francisco.

Three-fourths of the project's financing will be provided by the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul. A fund-raising campaign is in progress for the \$4 million balance. Commitments toward the goal have been made by Providence employees, medical staff and Our Lady of Providence League volunteer organization.

Increased pressure from an expanding community produced the need for expanded facilities. Nearly 34,000 patients were treated daily at the hospital in 1975. Providence moved to Southfield in 1983 from its original location on West Grand Boulevard in Detroit where it had been since 1880.
