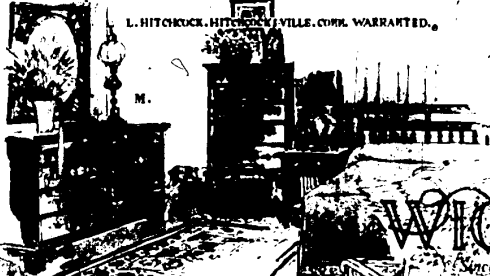

Hospital boosts troubled babies

If your baby is in trouble at birth, chances are that Pontiac General Hospital (PGH) can help it survive. The premature intensive care unit is a long name for a special place at Pontiac General Hospital—a separate nursery where troubled babies get a boost toward life from sophisticated equipment and specially trained nurses whose single purpose is to keep them alive. Premature infants, those born with respiratory distress syndrome (RDS) and others who don't do well in the first few minutes of life—225 babies in 1975—have been receiving intensive care here since 1972. "There's no way we can say for sure that all those babies would have died," says Dr. Donald Trumpbour, chief of pediatrics at Pontiac General Hospital, "but we have saved some lives and probably supported the potential life of many more." TECHNIQUES DEVELOPED to save premature babies overflow to those not as sick who now get more knowledgeable care. If they're slow starters or have suffered difficulties at birth, we can help them better than we used to. Breathing difficulties account for the greatest number of babies placed in the intensive care unit, located away from the glass-walled term nursery with its 60 bassinets. RDS, sometimes called hyaline membrane disease, occurs when immature lungs can't expand properly due to collapsed air sacs. With poor expansion, sufficient oxygen gets into the baby's blood stream, causing possible brain damage. Breathing may stop. Just the right amount of oxygen is called for. Too much can result in retrolental fibroplasia, which causes blindness. A plastic dome which fits over the baby's head like a large bubble holds the oxygen inside, while warming lights regulate the temperature surrounding him or her. Monitors continuously check heart beat and breathing, making a sound like an incessantly bouncing ping pong ball. If a drastic change occurs in either rate, an alarm will alert nurses. On the tiny arms of some babies, tubes are inserted for intravenous feedings. Others, large enough to nurse from bottles, are fed in the arms of nurses. SURROUNDED BY GLEAMING steel equipment, an old-fashioned rocking chair waits for feeding time; its seat covered with a patchwork cushion. It symbolizes the loving care of nurses who, while constantly watchful, talk to and cuddle babies well enough to be held.
