Lathrup tops Dondero Jays win again, rip Hazel Park

Southfield High continued its amazing baseball season by trouncing once-powerful Hazel Park, 11-7, in a Southeastern Michigan Association game last Monday.

Southfield, a youthful team which was considered a question mark before the season started, now has a 6-1 SMA record and shares the league lead with Royal Oak Kinnelon. The Blue Jays are 6-0 overall.

"Yeah, it makes me feel good to beat Hazel Park. It makes me feel good to beat anybody," said Tahir Fletcher, Southfield's first-year baseball coach. "Our kids believe in themselves. That's the main thing."

"We're playing last downtown baseball. That's where we saw we're never out of a ballgame. We can be down by 10 runs, but we can have a big inning and come back and win the game."

Southfield needed no such rally against Hazel Park. The Jays pounded out nine hits and scored in every inning but the sixth. Bruce Sher, a senior shortstop, knocked in three runs with a pair of homers and a single. Teammate Jeff Schubert contributed two hits and drove in three runs.

Dane Smith, a sophomore just elevated from the reserves, was the winning pitcher. He worked three innings, giving up four hits. Eric King started and pitched the first three innings, and John Vignola

Farmington Harrison pitcher Gregg Mathiak, a junior right-hander, continued his impressive season by throwing a three-hitter to help the Hawks defeat Waterford West, 4-2, in a Western Six League baseball game recently.

Mathiak, who has allowed just one earned run in 21 innings of work, now has a 4-0 record. Against West, he worked five innings and gave up one run.

"He wasn't on like he has been, but he did a good job," said Harrison coach John Harrison, whose team is 4-4 overall and 2-2 in the WSL. "Mathiak is a real tough pitcher—no overpowering speed, but a sneaky fastball and a good breaking curve."

Harrison, which had seven hits, scored two runs in the fourth inning on Paul Rog's single. Brett Hommer singled in another run, and Chris Kallgren added two hits.

Last Saturday, Harrison and Birmingham Groves split a double header, with Harrison winning the first game, 7-4, and losing the rematch, 6-1. Hommer was the winning pitcher, striking out 14 batters, in the opener.
